Module 1 Title: Who I am. What I have Session 1 Title: I am a believer

Hi Overflow Kids, welcome! It's very exciting to be here together. We are going to read God's word, were going to have fun, and were going to learn the truth. The topic for today that were looking at is I am a believer. What is it?

Kids: I am a believer

That's right. You know believing is very import, to believe in something, but you need to believe in the right thing, the truth, what's right and what's true. You know a lot of people believe all sorts of things and some of them are a little bit crazy. You know years ago, people believed that the world was flat, like a pancake.

And they believed that, if they were in a boat and they sailed and they kept going, they'd fall off the edge of the world. So a lot of people were afraid that they were sailing too far, but we know that the earth is round, it is a globe, that it is suspended by the power of God, in gravity.

People also believed that we were made from apes, that we came from apes, that's not the truth because the Bible says, 'we are created by God in the image of God'. So that's the truth.

We are going to turn in our Bibles, to God's Word, let's find John chapter 20:29. There are a couple of things that I want to tell you before we read. One of those things is that God knows everything, what does God know?

Kids: Everything

And He can't lie, so when you read God's Word you can know that it's the truth. (Reads Scripture).

Now let me tell you about this. Jesus was talking to Thomas; Thomas was one of Jesus' friends, His disciples. Jesus had died and risen from the dead and he'd appeared to the other disciples but Thomas wasn't in the room when Jesus came, so, they told Thomas; 'Thomas, we've seen Jesus, He's alive! And Thomas said I don't believe, unless I see the nail prints in His hands, unless I can put my hand in His side, where they pierced him, I won't believe.

Jesus actually came again and appeared to the disciples and Thomas was there! And Jesus was so kind and so gracious. He said, Thomas come here let me show you. Thomas saw the nail prints in Jesus' hand, and He said Thomas give me your hand and he put them in His side, Thomas felt where the saw had pierced Jesus. And he said Oh Lord I believe! And this is where Jesus said 'Thomas you

believe because you have seen me, I want to bless those who have never seen me and yet believe. Is that you? That's me. Have you ever seen Jesus?

Kids: NO!

I've never seen Him with my own eyes, but you know what, I've seen Him in here (Bible), I've read out Him, and when I read about all the miracles, all the wonderful things that He did, not just for big people. Jesus healed children, Jesus loved children. One day He picked the children up in His arms, the Bible says and He blessed them, He blessed them with a blessing of love. So you know what, you can know that Jesus loves you and He blesses you but you've got to believe. Another word for believe is trust, you've got to trust. So believing is trusting.

It's like a guide dog leading somebody who can't see, they trust that dog. And God can be trusted as he leads us and guides us through our life. So keep believing and trusting!

You know that to believe in God is the way to go! Many of you right now want give your hearts and say 'Yah, I believe in God'. But sometimes you need to say it with our own mouth, you need to what the Bible says, confess it, say 'I believe'. Shut your eyes right now and have a look in your heart; you can think about things, and you can say to your self 'do I really believe in God?'

Those of you who want to ask Jesus into their hearts today, you can do that by saying this pray and saying it with belief. Let's say it:

*Jesus I come to you now
And I say I believe in you
You died for me
You rose from the dead
And you are coming again
Jesus, wash me clean of all my sin
I give you my heart, My life
In your name I pray
Amen*

Amen, means, yah so be it, let it be done! Everybody shout Amen. You're a believer.

Prayer for everyone This is the way that I like to pray, when I am receiving something from God I put my hand out, close your eyes.

You're OK, I'm OK and God is awesome!

Hi Overflow Kids, welcome to another exciting episode of looking into the Word of God together. Are you excited?

Kids: Yes!

Are you ready?

Kids: I was born ready Hu!

That's fantastic, well today's topic is called I am a child of God. And you know what, you need to know that. God is your Father, He is your loving Father and you are His child. Ok so, when you are apart of a family, you belong. And so being apart of God's family means your part of a huge family, people all over the world, who believe in Jesus Christ. That's how you get into the family of God.

You know what, my children; I've got Elizabeth, a daughter and now, a son in law and two grand children. Well when they come to my house, they are allowed to go into the fridge and check it out and take what ever they want out of the fridge because they are family. Now if you came to visit me and you when straight up to the fridge, I might say, 'Hang on a minute, don't you have to ask first'. Well I would ask you to ask me, 'Can I get something out of the fridge', and I'd say 'Yes', because I love you.

But being a part of God's family, means that we have the privileges of being a child of God. Let's find out about that. We are going to turn to our Bibles and the Scripture for today is Galatians 3:26. It's a very short verse. So look at it carefully, because this is what God says to you.

Remember I said that the way to get into God's family is to have faith and believe Jesus.

I want to tell you a story from the Bible, a young boy, they call him the prodigal son, that means a wasteful son, this son when to his father and asked for some money, the money that would belong to him when his father died. So he gave the money to both of his sons, the younger son and the older son.

The younger son went out and he wasted the money, he spent it on stuff that just wasted the money away. And while he was away his father was already waiting for him to come back. The boy had left, the father's heart was 'I miss my son, I love my son'. While the son was away, he got so hungry he even wanted to eat pig food.

He was starving and the earth was having a famine, or where he was going had a famine that means that there

was not much food. And he was starving and so he said, 'I know, I'll go back to my father's house, I'll go back and ask him, I can be a servant?'

So as he was going he thought about it and his father was waiting outside. He was looking down the road. I'm sure that he was looking every day for his son to come home. And there he was he saw his son coming down the road. And the Bible says that the father kissed the son's neck, and he loved on him, and he said, 'I'm so glad your home', and the son said, 'I'm not worthy to be your son anymore, I'll work for you.

The father said, 'no you're my son, you'll always be my son', and then they had a big party, and he did amazing things, he gave him a ring for his finger, and gave him a new cloak. That son must have been amazed. Because he just wanted to serve his dad because he thought 'I'm not worthy', but the dad's heart was full of forgiveness. Everybody say forgiveness.

Kids: Forgiveness

That means when you do something, to hurt somebody else, or somebody does something to hurt you, you can forgive. And the greatest forgiveness is when Jesus forgave us for doing our wrong doings.
